### Dignity For All Students Act (DASA)

The Dignity for All Students Act prohibits harassment and/or discrimination of students by employees or other students on school property or at school functions based upon a student's actual or perceived race, color, weight, national origin, ethnic group, religion, religious practice, disability, sexual orientation, gender or sex.

Incidences of bullying and/or harassment should be reported to the school district by completing a Sidney Central School District Bully Prevention Form or Sidney Central School District Complaint Form 3420F (this form is to be used for all complaints within the Sidney Central School District, including incidents of alleged discrimination or harassment.) These forms are located in the Guidance Office, in each building's main office, and on the District's website: <a href="https://www.sidneycsd.org">www.sidneycsd.org</a>. Forms can be deposited into any specified drop boxes in the building or turned into the main office.

### Immunizations

New York State requires all children be immunized against polio, rubella, diphtheria, mumps, measles and hepatitis B. Proof of immunization for new students must be presented for admission.

### Kindergarten Admission

To be enrolled in kindergarten, a child must be five years old on or before December 1 of the year of entrance. Birth certificates are required at registration. Health information, proof of immunization and proof of residency are also necessary for admission.



School Closings

If it is necessary to close schools due to bad road conditions in the winter, etc., parents will be notified by phone via our automated system. Please make sure your phone numbers are updated with school offices so that you receive these calls. We will also post closings and/or early dismissals on the school's website. Announcements will also be made on the following radio/TV stations: WCDO and WBNG-TV. Please do not call the schools!

### Transportation

Students going to a destination other than home must have a note signed by a parent and initialed by a building principal or by their designee.

### Bus Routes/Village Transportation Policies

### School Campus Traffic Rules

The speed limit on school property is 10 miles per hour. The main driveway at the High School is to be kept clear at all times. This means no parking there when waiting for students.

Car drivers should be aware that it is a violation of Section 1174 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law to pass a stopped school bus with red warning lights flashing, even in school driveways.

Students going to a destination other than home must have a note signed by a parent and initialed by a building principal or by their designee.


### Tobacco Use Prohibited

The Board of Education prohibits the use of tobacco products in any form at all times, including non-

school hours, on school property, on school grounds, in school vehicles, or at any school-sponsored event or activity off-campus. The Board of Education also prohibits the use of tobacco products in personal vehicles on school grounds.







### Medication

The employees of the school district do not have the qualifications to practice medicine. However, under certain circumstances, when it is necessary for a child to take internal medication during school hours, the school nurse/nurse-teacher may cooperate with the family physician and the parents. A written request to the school authorities from the parent/guardian and a written request from the family physician indicating the type, frequency and dosage of prescribed medication and the condition being treated is necessary to allow the school nurse/nurse-teacher to administer this medication during school hours. The medication must be in its original container. A verbal or telephone request from the parent or physician is not acceptable. Students are not to have any medication in school unless they are following the above rules.

### Accident Insurance

The Sidney Central School District provides student accident insurance through a group plan underwritten by the Insurance Company of North America, a division of CIGNA administrated by the Allen J. Flood Company. This insurance is a secondary plan designed to supplement the family's primary policy. If your child is injured in a school sponsored activity, you will need to file your claim within 90 days at the District Office or call 561-7700, option 1, for more information.

### Absences

Parents should notify the school nurse when a student is going to be absent for any reason. This allows the school personnel to know that the child is home safe and that the parent is aware of the absence. A written note of why the student was absent is required upon their return to school.

# Release of Children from School

Board of Education policy provides for release of children from school to authorized persons only. Each year, parents will be asked to designate in writing any persons so authorized.

### Facilities Use

Community use of district buildings is encouraged by the Board of Education. Fees are charged to defray associated expenses. Interested groups should make arrangements with the principal of the building involved and fill out the proper paperwork. Since buildings are used so extensively, requests should be made early. Liability insurance coverage is required.
